

The swimming pool is exclusively reserved for residents of the establishment Keep the door closed + child lock



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE AQUALARM SWIMMING POOL ALARM FOR VILLAS

## AQUALARM must always be in monitoring mode when there is no swimming in progress.

#### 1. WHEN YOU ARRIVE, AQUALARM IS IN MONITORING MODE

The alarm system does not replace the vigilance of responsible adults.

STATUS	ASSOCIATED SIGNAL	POSSIBLE ACTIONS
Under supervision (Swimming prohibited)	Flashing green light	Switch to swimming mode by entering the confidential code

The alarm is triggered when a fall or activity in the pool is detected while the system is in surveillance mode. It is imperative to react when the alarm sounds and to intervene as soon as possible.

STATUS	ASSOCIATED SIGNAL	POSSIBLE ACTIONS
Alarm in progress	Siren triggered	- Stop siren by pressing any button - Automatic shutdown after 60 seconds: surveillance is temporarily deactivated, it is automatically reactivated

#### 2. YOU WANT TO SWIM

You enter your confidential code on the control panel: 1234

You then have 10 minutes (automatic reactivation time) to enter the water.

STATUS	ASSOCIATED SIGNAL	POSSIBLE ACTIONS
Unattended (Swim Mode)	Flashing red light	It is recommended to wait for the system to reactivate itself for optimal sensitivity. If the pond is too agitated, the switch to manual mode will be refused and a low-pitched beep will be heard.

If you do not return within the time limit, the system does not detect any activity in the water and the alarm automatically reactivates. You are alerted to the impending reactivation by beeps. You can press any key to return to swim mode. If you do not intervene, a longer final beep will be heard and the system will return to monitoring mode. The user must be aware that human supervision must take over.

#### 3. AFTER SWIMMING

The system reactivates automatically when the pool is calm. The system informs you of the imminent reactivation of the surveillance by the lights that flash alternately, but especially by close beeps. Be careful, if the pool is not completely calm, the manual reactivation may be refused or the siren may be triggered.

The use of the communal swimming pools is not allowed for the tenants of the villas.

#### INFORMATION ABOUT MY RENTAL



Everyne's attention is drawn to the fact that tenants and owners are bound by basic rules detailed below:

- a) Excessive noise of any kind is forbidden
- b) The drying of **laundry** outside of houses is forbidden
- c) **Pets**: you can't allow a dog to roam off the lead or to defecate in communal areas (should this nonetheless happen, the mess must be immediately and scrupulously cleaned up)
- d) Vehicle: no vehicle may be driven faster than 20 km/h within the confines of your hamlet
- e) **Golf buggies**: may not exceed 5 km/h after dark and may not, at any time, be driven by children less than 18 years old
- f) **Private vehicles**: may only be parked in the space allocated to the concerned house or in a space allocated for visitors' parking
- g) Children are not allowed to play ball or other games on the roads.
- h) **Swimming pool**: see the rules at the pool entrance. Tenants of semi-detached villas only have access to the common swimming pool of their residence. Tenants of individual villas only have access to their individual pool.
- i) **Pool and Garden maintenance**: For Estagnol townhouses, the garden maintenance takes place on Tuesday and/or Friday. For Aureto townhouses, it takes place on Monday and/or Tuesday and/or Thursday. For the villas, the garden maintenance is done once per week and the pool maintenance is done every 3 days. Please note that this planning cannot be change.
- j) An **inventory list** of the items of your house has been given to you in your arrival file. Please take the time to check it and bring it back undersigned (eventually with your comments) at the rental office (close to the Spa) within 48hrs.
- In case we don't receive back the inventory or if any damage is not reported on it, we inform that it will be your responsability.
- k) **Wind**: In order to prevent any damage due to the wind, always leave the shutters secured. 3 possible position: Closed / Open on the catches / Crossed

Please always leave the parasols closed when the weather is windy and/or when you are away.

- 1) **Barbecues**: due to the high risk of fires, please note that charcoal barbecues are strictly forbidden on the resort.
- m) **Security**: our resort is secured (guard at the entrance gate night patrols). Nevertheless, we recommend closing the ground floor window shutters while you are away and during the night.
- n) **Garbage**: For public health and hygienic reasons, under no circumstances may rubbish be left other than in one of the containers provided for that purpose always in sealed bags available in supermarkets or provided in the cleaning kits.
- o) Departure of your accommodation: BEFORE 10AM

The day before your departure, please go to the reception desk to pay for your drinks and to inform us of your approximate departure time. The day of your departure thank you to respect the following points quoted in the following page.

This document will be given to you at your arrival against signature so that the tenant commits himself to respect the rules of joint ownership attached during his stay.



## **RENTAL CHECK-OUT**

The departure of the rental must be done before 10:00 am.

Before leaving, please:

- Put dirty sheets and towels in the bathtub
- Throw away disposable pillow protectors and undersheets
- Non-disposable undersheets, pillowcases and pillowcases, blankets and bedspreads should be left on site
- Empty all garbage cans
- Clean and tidy the kitchen: no dishes in the sink, the dishwasher must be emptied and the oven cleaned if it has been used
- Close all windows and shutters
- Lock all doors accessible from the outside

Be sure to leave the keys in the mailbox of the rental office if you leave outside of business hours (9am-5pm).










## **NATURAL SITES TO VISIT**

#### The blavet gorges

Between Bagnols-en-forêt and La Bouverie, the Gorges du Blavet are a rock formation dug over time into the volcanic rocks of the massif. Discover the Gorges du Blavet for hiking or even climbing! With its breathtaking landscapes, take the time to admire them and breathe a little!






#### Rock of Roquebrune

An unmissable rock overlooking the Argens plain, it's the ideal destination for a fun family hike. The Rock of Roquebrune, a classified site of national interest culminates at 373 meters in height. From there, you can discover a superb 360° view of the Argens valley, Fréjus, the Estérel and, in the distance, the Alps.

#### Gorges du Verdon

In the heart of the Verdon Regional Natural Park, this enormous canyon forms a huge gash that seems to have been created by the gods. It is the result of the incredible power of erosion in the Verdon onto the limestone plateaus of Provence. The canyon can be explored by canoe or on foot. It can also be admired from the road which offers stunning viewpoints





### The island of Porquerolles

A church, with Mexican accents, sits enthroned on the village square hemmed with giant eucalyptus trees around which cheerfully wrap café terraces and very simple houses abundantly flowered. Perched on a promontory, the stocky Fort Sainte-Agathe stands guard. Next to it, the pretty mill of happiness, fully restored. Take on foot or by bike its paths lined with pines, myrtles and heather... Cliffs and wild creeks, long golden beaches, valleys fringed with vineyards.

Certified as one of the 'Most Beautiful Villages in France', Seillans is a particularly charming village that has kept the soul of the Provençal hilltop villages. Its terraced houses, inconceivably interlaced with cobbled streets, shaded squares, craftspeople and artists make it a charming place to visit.

#### Villecroze

A Tuscan garden and caves for a castle! "Village of Character", Villecroze has retained its medieval character with its arcades, narrow streets, fountains and church. To the north of the village stands a cliff from which flows a waterfall that waters the Tuscan garden at its feet. This cliff offers a whole maze of small caves which served as shelters for the inhabitants.

#### Abbey of Thoronet

In the heart of the Var hinterland, Thoronet Abbey is one of the "three Provençal sisters", along with the abbeys of Sénanque and Silvacane. Built at the end of the 12th century, Thoronet Abbey is a model of architecture in terms of the purity of its lines, the simplicity of its volumes, its harmonious proportions and its exceptional acoustics. The absolute stripping of its architecture is a source of inspiration for many 20th century architects, including Le Corbusier.











#### Cloister of the Cathedral of Fréjus

Medieval ensemble of beautiful architectural unity, the episcopal group consists of a cathedral surrounded by remarkable buildings: baptistery, cloister on two floors, canonical buildings. The painted wooden ceiling of the cloister presents an exceptional bestiary of fantastic animals.
